EINSTEIN'S DREAMS In this nonlinear one-act play, based on Alan Lightman's surreal novel, a twenty-six-year-old Einstein

(Jared Coseglia) stumbles through his past, present, and future as characters from his life-his wife, his sons, his best friend, and a notional daughter

named Lieserl-elucidate his theories of space and time, their explanations lit by naked, dangling light bulbs. In the director Rebecca Holderness's poetic,

visual dreamscape, time stops, moves forward and
