Rebecca Holderness will discuss instances where library research and resources were instrumental in developing live theater performance and production. The discussion will include phases of the creative theater process, and how and what kind of research might impact those processes. Holderness will share slides of performances as well as show dramaturgy notebooks from past performances, including the UWM Mainstage productions of *Of Mice and Men* (spring 2008) and 1001 (fall 2008).

Prof. Holderness is a nationally recognized theater and film director, and for many years was proprietor and director of the New York City-based Holderness Theater Company. She teaches acting and movement at UWM.
